Boatyard Terms and Conditions

- All boats must have a minimum of Third Party Insurance. Certificate of Currency must be sighted by OCM staff before lifting.
- Please advise office staff if you intend to undertake grinding or spray painting.
- The person responsible for your safety while on the boatyard is you. Please take care while climbing on and off the boat and while on ladders and scaffolds. Ensure your ladder is securely tied to your boat. Be aware of the Travelift and other heavy vehicle movements. Ensure planks are secured to scaffolds.
- Please use the hardstand washbasin to remove paint, grease dirt etc prior to using the bathroom and laundry facilities. It is located next to the Travelift shed.
- Do not adjust or move any of the props, or the cradle that the boat is sitting in, without consulting the boatyard staff.
- To avoid dirty airborne spray the pressure washer wand must not be pointed above horizontal at any time and must always be pointed towards the water, not the boatyard.
- To minimise hazardous dust, vacuum systems must be used while mechanical dry sanding. Wet or dry hand sanding is permitted without the use of vacuum system. Vacuum sanders are available for hire from the boatyard.
- Please be aware of other boats around you. Ensure you minimise any dust, spray or anything else which may be a nuisance to others.
- Clean up all rubbish, waste paint scrapings and fibreglass materials daily. More frequently during windy weather.
- Please ensure your site is swept, all rubbish picked up and all scaffolds and planks are placed back on the stacks prior to launching.
- Do not leave your car on any of the Travelift clearways. Ask the boatyard staff to clarify if you are unsure. This is an industrial site so if you park your car on the boatyard you do so entirely at your risk. The 10km/h speed limit must be adhered to at all times.
- Please give the office staff at least one day's notice when you are ready to relaunch.
- Slipping is to be paid before relaunch.
- Spray painting can only commence if the wind speed is below 10kph on the OCM weather station. Consult the office or download the app to monitor wind speeds.
- Screens must always be used if spray-painting or grinding. Screens must be anchored when in use.
- The boatyard is an industrial worksite and as such is prone to dust, noise and overspray. It is the boat-owners responsibility to minimise impacting on adjoining boats and also to protect their own boat from any airborne contaminants.
- Owners use the boatyard at their own risk. Oyster Cove Marina will not be held responsible for any damage occurring to vessels while in the boatyard.
